



## Adventure Trails \*EXAMPLE\* Schedule

### ARRIVAL DAY

- Arrivals, Introductions, & "Get to Know You" games

### DAY 1

- Camper Saddle Duty – Pull, Groom and Tack their own horse for the main trail.
- Spruce Mountain Trail Ride
- Lunch on Spruce Mountain
- Head back to camp, feed, and untack horses

### DAY 2

- Ranch Hands Moring – Learn about feeding, grooming and the difference from English and Western riding equipment
- Arena Work English Riding Walk Trot Canter – trotting poles, small jumps if advanced enough
- Vaulting

### DAY 3

- Camper Saddle Duty – Pull, Groom and Tack their own horse for the main trail.
- Hassayampa River Trail Ride
- Lunch by the River
- Head back to camp, feed, and untack horses

### DAY 4

- Pony Care and Cart Driving
- Arena Work: small jumps, warm up for cross country
- Cross Country/Trail jumping

### DAY 5

- Camper Saddle Duty – Pull, Groom and Tack their own horse for the main trail
- Game DAY: Jousting, bareback games, barrel racing, lasso barrels etc
- Final trail ride
